Object Handling Workshop

45 minute (approx.)

Facilitated session

In this museum-led object handling workshop, pupils will have the opportunity to engage with our collection through storytelling and handling. Our narrators will take your pupils on an immersive cultural journey whilst hearing the stories of local transport innovators, stories from Dundee's transport past as well as look into what the future of transport may be like. Throughout, your students will be given to opportunity to ask questions but also be encouraged to think about the objects in front of them and the stories that lie beneath.

Learning outcomes:

Your pupils will:

- Develop communication skills and their confidence
- Develop an awareness of the past
- Learn through storytelling
- Consider how the design of vehicles has changed over time
- Encourages classroom discussion
- Develop enquiry skills and ask relevant questions
