



SCAMP'S TRANSPORT THROUGHOUT TIME TRAIL

Primary 1-7

1 hour (approx)
Self-guided or guided

This trail is designed to help pupils understand the development of transport from the 18th Century until the present day. This can be a self-directed or a guided activity, just let us know! The trail will take about an hour to complete.

Individually, your pupils will have the chance to learn some fun facts about our collection, answer questions, design their own vehicles and take part in a drama activity using the Transport Throughout Time Booklet. These exercises will aid students in their understanding of transportation, technology, as well as local history. They will also have the opportunity to sit in some of our vehicles and let their imagination run wild.

- Learn about vehicles from the past and present
- Develop a good knowledge of local and global history
- Develop personal and social skills
- Engage with the museum's collection
- Consider how the design of vehicles has changed over time
