This is an exciting time to get involved with Dundee Museum of Transport. The Museum has been open at its Market Mews site for four years, is developing a fantastic collection of transport-related objects and has established itself as an important attraction within the City. In May 2018 Dundee Museum of Transport was awarded Accredited status by Museums Galleries Scotland in recognition of the continuing development of the museum. The Museum is open to the public six days a week (March – October) and three days per week (November – February) and, in 2017, attracted over 10,000 paid visitors.

The museum is managed by a Museum Manager and small team of enthusiastic volunteers. The Board of Trustees meet monthly, normally a Wednesday evening, during the last week of the month and a number of sub-committees have been set-up to support specific areas of the museum, from events to finance.
